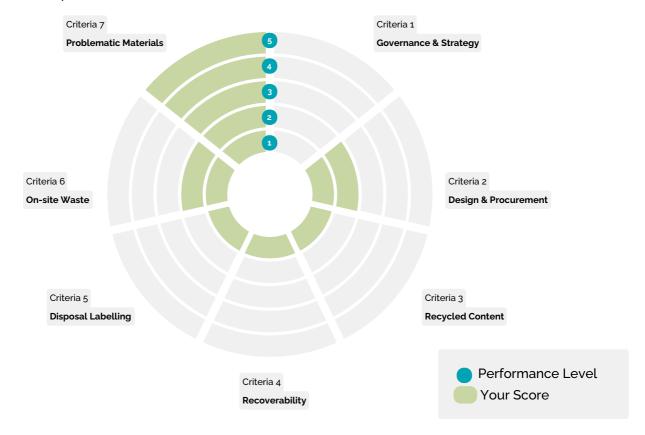

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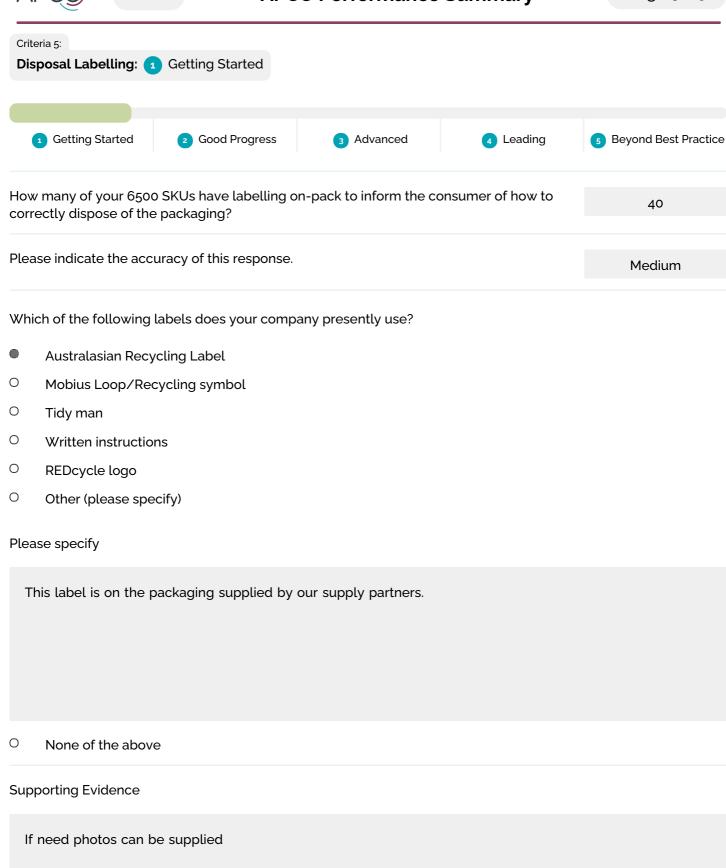

We have collected reusable cores and pallets from our customers to reuse in our warehouse rather then buy new pallets or have then put into landfill.

We have tried through numerous channels to have people collect our recyclable material from the warehouse, unfortunately due to our location we have been unsuccessful on a number of products.

We have our own truck go to our franchise stores and collect all reusable cores and pallets. If we did not do this, these items would end up in landfill. We then reuse these items so that we do not have to use more material to purchase new products. With pallets they can be reused up to 20 times providing they are not damaged in transit.
